



## Elementary Art

Art, as in all other classes, first and foremost provides a Christ-centered environment. Biblical Principles are used as guides in all aspects of the student experience during art period.

In addition, the elementary visual arts curriculum consists of lessons designed around five themes: skills and techniques, creation and communication, cultural and historical connections, aesthetic and critical analysis, and applications to life.

The broad objectives are:

- The student understands and applies media, techniques, and processes.
- The student creates and communicates a range of subject matter, symbols, and ideas using knowledge of structures and functions of visual arts.
- The student understands the visual arts in relation to history and culture.
- The student assesses, evaluates, and responds to the characteristics of works of art.
- The student makes connections between the visual arts, other disciplines, and the real world.

Art is incorporated into computer first semester, Spanish all year, and stands alone second semester.
